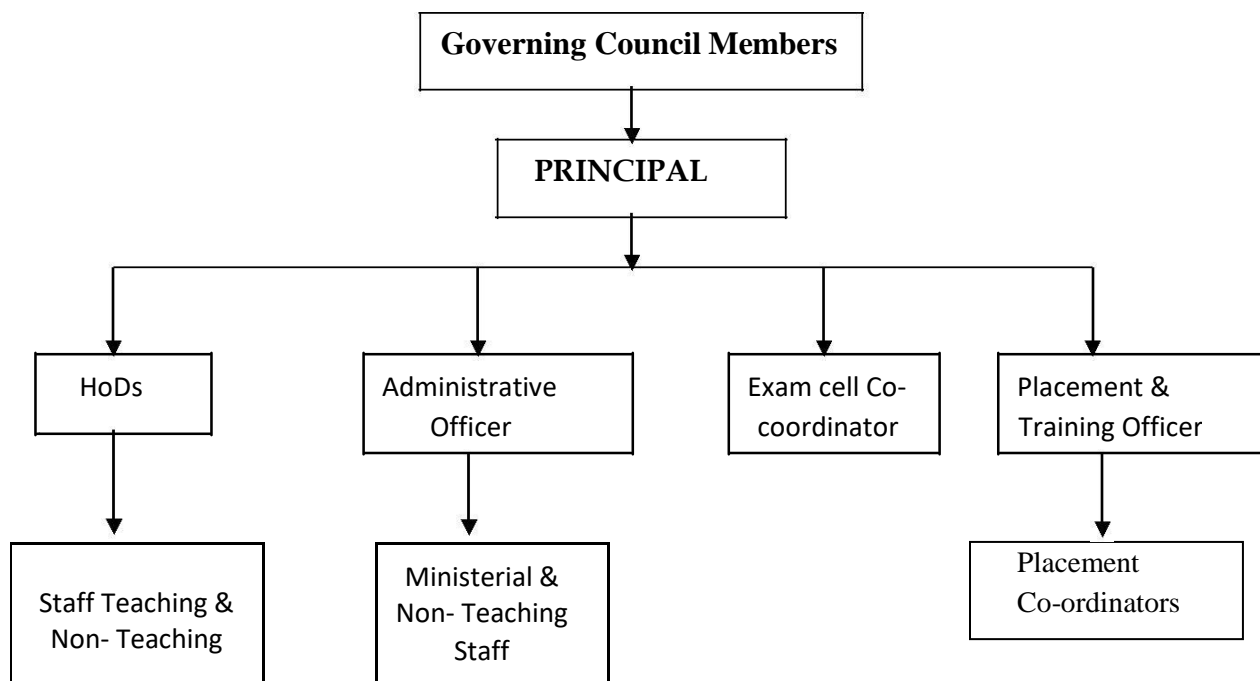

Mentoring and counseling Services.

Every teaching staff is attached with 15 students and take care of the academic related counseling and also monitor the attendance and academic progress of the students. 
